

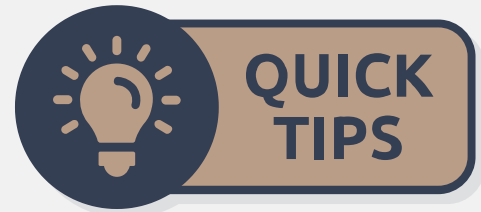

Alert: Protect Yourself from Unsolicited Medicare Calls

Scammers are targeting Medicare beneficiaries with unsolicited phone calls, trying to steal your information and hard-earned money. Stay vigilant and safeguard your benefits.

- Fraudsters often claim to be from Medicare or your insurance company, promising free services or benefits you didn't request.
- Scammers will create urgency, pressuring you to provide personal information or make immediate payments.
- Fraudsters may threaten to cancel your benefits if you don't comply with their demands.
- Legitimate Medicare representatives will never ask for payments over the phone.
- Never share your Social Security number, Medicare ID, or financial details over the phone.

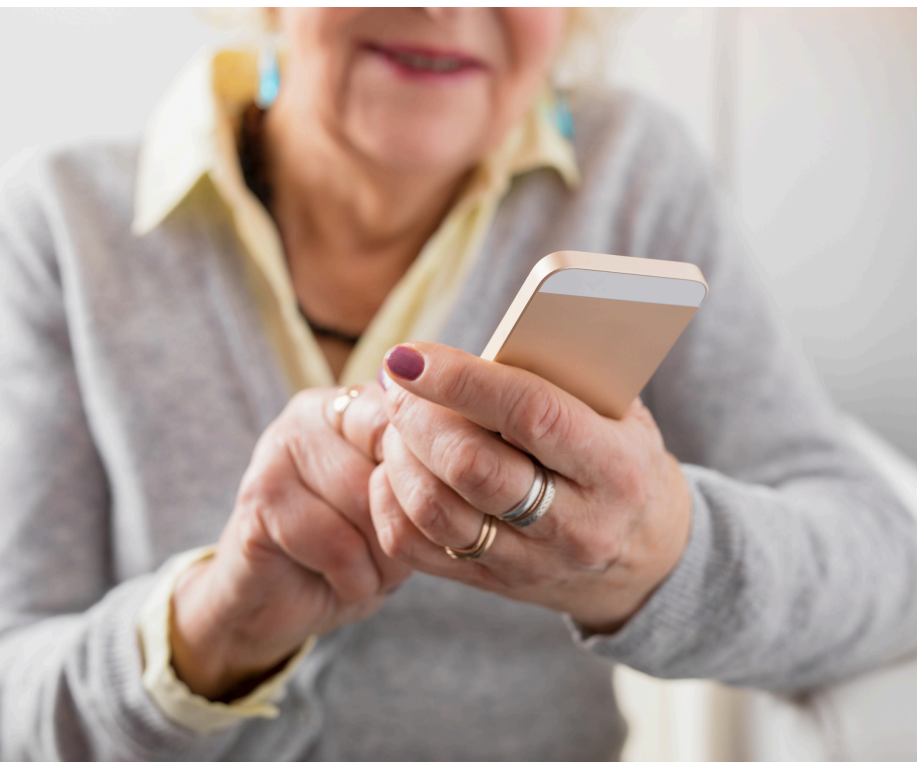
Did you know?

Fraudsters have technology that can make it look like it's coming from a number you can trust. Be wary if they are asking for personal information and you don't recognize the voice.



What You Can Do

- If you receive an unsolicited call, hang up immediately if the caller requests personal information, payment, or sounds suspicious.
- Scammers often already have some of your information. Don't verify any details - they might use it against you.
- If you're unsure, call Medicare or your insurance company directly to confirm any requests.



Report a Suspicious Call



If you encounter a suspicious call, report it to the Federal Trade Commission (FTC) at ftc.gov/complaint or call 1-800-MEDICARE
